Peel Golf Club (The Club) Competition Mens Singles and Doubles Matchplay Terms and Conditions

In effect from March 15th, 2026.

The following terms and conditions are specific to Matchplay competitions organised by the Club and should be read in conjunction with the full Club Competition Conditions issued March 15, 2025. These can be found on the Club Policies tab on the Clubs website or on the Clubhouse Noticeboard.

Entry

Entry to the Club singles and doubles Matchplay competitions will be advertised and is open to all male members with a valid WHS handicap. Payment for the competition must be made on registration. Players must also submit contact information by way of telephone and e-mail address which will be held on the gent's locker room noticeboard. This information will be removed from the locker room once the competition is completed.

Playing Handicaps

Handicaps for each player will be the applicable course handicap on the day that the match takes place. Handicaps are capped at max 28. Your adjustments should be done as follows:

Singles:

The higher-handicapped player receives the full difference between the Course Handicaps of the two players; the lower-handicapped player shall play from scratch. Example: A player with a Course Handicap of 17 shall receive four strokes from a player with a Course Handicap of 13.

Doubles:

Players receive 90% of their course handicap and take the difference from the lowest player. See appendix 1 for written example.

Match Scheduling

For Singles and Matchplay the draw for fixtures will be made by the Committee and put on to the noticeboard in the clubhouse. It is the responsibility of the participants to have fixtures arranged and games played in advance of the deadline for each round. The first player on the draw is responsible for contacting the opposing player. If the opposing player fails to reply in time, they will be disqualified.

Any issues in arranging fixtures within the deadlines must be notified to the Committee 7 days in advance of the deadline date.

Note (i) No matches may be arranged for a Tuesday night tee off time before 7pm (ii) Matches played on a Wednesday cannot proceed until all Club Night competitors have commenced. You cannot play in a Club Night competition alongside a Match Play fixture.

Any match played that breaches the above conditions will be declared null and void.

Matchplay scoring

Scorecards or final results for all games must be either placed in the scorecard box, handed to the Club Professional, or e-mailed to secretary@peelgc.com as soon as possible, and no later than 48 hours after completion of the match. The Committee will update the results on the locker room notice board and Masterscoreboard.

Disputes

Any disputes must be reported to the Committee in writing immediately. The Committee's decision will be final.

Doubles:

Step 1: Course Handicaps – For each player, convert their Handicap Index into a Course Handicap using the White Index Chart.

Step 2: Handicap allowances – Adjust your course handicap to 90%, rounding to the nearest whole number

Step 3: Handicap difference – Adjust each Playing Handicap down so the lowest handicap plays off zero.

Example:

Step 1: Course Handicaps

Player 1: Handicap Index 8.9 = 11

Player 2: Handicap Index 14.2 = 17

Player 3: Handicap Index 19.8 = 24

Player 4: Handicap Index 20.6 = 25

Step 2: 90% Allowance

Player 1: $11 \times 90\% = 9.9$, rounded to 10

Player 2: $17 \times 90\% = 15.3$, rounded to 15

Player 3: $24 \times 90\% = 21.6$, rounded to 22

Player 4: $25 \times 90\% = 22.5$, rounded to 23

Step 3: Adjusted for lowest handicap

Player 1: $10 - 10 = 0$

Player 2: $15 - 10 = 5$

Player 3: $22 - 10 = 12$

Player 4: $23 - 10 = 13$
